



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN**

**RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY THANYABURI
PATHUMTHANI PROVINCE, THAILAND**

AND

LONDON SOUTH BANK UNIVERSITY, LONDON, UNITED KINGDOM

IN ORDER to promote co-operation between **Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi** and London Southbank University, the following has been agreed:

Both Universities will encourage direct contact and operation between their faculty members, departments, and schools.

The two Universities will endeavor to co-operate in education and research areas of mutual interest.

Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the following general forms of co-operation will be pursued:

1. Student exchange programmes
2. Faculty/staff exchange programmes
3. Cultural exchange programmes
4. Cooperative degree programmes

Themes of joint activities and the most appropriate way of utilizing the results achieved, arrangement for specific visits, exchanges, and other forms of co-operation will be developed mutually in each specific instance.

Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.



The agreement will remain in effect until one part notifies the other of its wish to terminate the agreement at least ninety (90) days before the end of the academic year.
