



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY THANYABURI, THAILAND
AND
SEOUL WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY, KOREA



Seoul Women's University and Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi, wishing to enhance relations between the two universities and to develop academic and cultural interchange in the areas of education, research and other activities, agree to cooperate and work together the internationalization of higher education.

The areas of cooperation will include any program offered at either university which is felt to be desirable and feasible for the development and strengthening of cooperative relationships between the two institutions. However, any specific program shall be subject to mutual consent, availability of funds, and approval of each university. Such programs may include:

- a. Exchange of faculty members
- b. Exchange of students
- c. Joint research project
- d. Joint cultural program
- e. Dual-degree or joint-degree program

The terms of such mutual assistance and cooperation shall be discussed and agreed upon in writing by the appropriate responsible officers of both parties prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity.

This agreement shall be effective upon approval by both parties and shall remain in effect until Sep. 30, 2013; provided, however, that it may be extended by mutual agreement expressed by a written memorandum of understanding.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, each of the institutions has caused this Agreement of Cooperation to be executed in duplicate by its duly authorized officer on the date set forth below. The Agreement of Cooperation shall not be in force until both institutions have caused both copies to be executed so that each institution shall have a fully executed original.
