



Memorandum of Understanding

between

Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi
Pathumthani Province, Thailand

and

Kungliga Tekniska högskolan
(the Royal Institute of Technology)
Stockholm, Sweden

Preamble

In furtherance of their mutual interests in the fields of education and research, Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi (hereafter RMUTT) and Kungliga Tekniska högskolan (hereafter KTH) hereby agree upon the following areas of cooperation:

- To engage in joint efforts in curriculum development, research and consultation on agreed topics of common interest;
- To work together in the area of university management, including exchanges of administrative and managerial staff where appropriate;
- To collaborate in the expansion of links with industry and agencies for public administration and public services;
- To develop the exchange of research and academic staff and student mobility with the view of promoting learning and culture and fostering close friendship between the two universities on the basis of principles of mutual benefit and equality.

This collaboration will be developed between appropriate schools, departments and units at the two universities, specified in agreements which are linked to this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

Article 1

The parties agree to seek mutually beneficial ways to share professional experiences and exchange information on research and teaching methodology, curricula, the training of specialist, and to explore and implement other forms of professional interaction and exchange.

Article 2

The parties agree to encourage the exchange of scholarly and educational publications and materials, as well as biographical, reference and other pertinent literature. The exchange of periodicals and other publications will be carried out by the libraries of the two universities based on mutual needs and interests.

Article 3

Each party agrees to invite representatives of the other party to participate in major congresses, conferences and symposia of mutual interest.

Article 4

This MoU does not exclude the possibility of organizing other forms of exchange or expanding this MoU should both parties so desire.

Article 5

Each university will nominate its own representative and such representative will be responsible for all measures to be undertaken under this MoU. Representatives for this Agreement are listed in Appendix A.

Article 6

This MoU shall come into effect on the day of approval by both universities with a duration of five years. Either university may terminate this MoU provided that written notice of the intent is given at least six months prior to termination. Commitments already in progress shall be fulfilled.

Article 7

Amendments or changes to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by the duly authorized representatives of the universities.

Article 8

The MoU has been signed in duplicate, of which, each university will receive one copy.
