## Memorandum of Understanding between Zhejiang University of Technology, China and Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi, Thailand on Academic and Research Collaboration

Zhejiang University of Technology and Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi (RMUTT) have agreed to the following protocols governing their collaboration on academic and research-related activities.

## Scope

The scope of collaboration on academic and research activities included in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

- Research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest;
- Exchange of academic materials which are made available by both parties;
- Exchange of scholars;
- Exchange of students;
- Cooperative seminars, workshops and other academic activities.

## **Implementation**

To implement this Memorandum, the following is mutually understood and agreed:

- Proposals for collaborative work under this Memorandum will be submitted through the normal procedures of each institution.
- This Memorandum allows for the development of separate faculty-to-faculty
  agreements wherein cooperative arrangements limited to those faculties are specified;
- Each university will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of any
  cooperative program. Individual programs of work developed under this
  Memorandum will be the subject of individual agreements in writing and where
  appropriate will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties.
- Progress of work of any individual program will be reviewed and approved by designated project officers of both parties, in accordance with its individual agreement.

- The final approval of any project will depend on the availability of the guaranteed support funds.
- Neither Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi nor Zhejiang University of Technology will be held responsible for any liability, and, neither party shall be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to any personal property to which this Memorandum relates.

## Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

This Memorandum of Understanding is effective as of the date of execution by the appropriate officer of each signatory institution. This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of signing, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving at least six months notice to the other party in writing. The agreement may be amended or extended by mutual consent in writing of the two parties.
