



AGREEMENT on COOPERATION

between

CHRISTCHURCH POLYTECHNIC INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

and

RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY THANYABURI

The Christchurch Polytechnic Institute of Technology (CPIT), Christchurch, New Zealand and Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi (RMUTT), Pathum Thani, Thailand wishing to establish a relationship between the two institutions; agree to cooperate with each other as follows:

Scope of the Cooperation

Subject to mutual consent, the areas of cooperation will include any of the activities listed below. Both parties will contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two institutions.

Cooperation shall be carried out through such activities as:

- Exchange of faculty or students
- Joint research activities and publications
- Participation in seminars and academic meetings
- Exchange of academic materials and other information
- Special short-term academic programs

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this Agreement on Cooperation shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such agreements entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this Agreement on Cooperation. A minimum period of six months notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate this Agreement. In the event of termination, all commitment to the students participating in the programme will be honoured by the relevant parties. Each institution shall designate a liaison person to develop and coordinate the specific activities agreed upon.
