

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

# RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY THANYABURI, THAILAND

#### AND

## DIAN NUSWANTORO UNIVERSITY, INDONESIA

Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi, Thailand and Dian Nuswantoro University, Indonesia, hereinafter referred to as "the two parties", fully recognizing that cooperation between the two parties would be beneficial to all concerned, hereby affirm their intention to encourage such cooperation.

This Memorandum of Understanding states that the two parties agree to act as follows:

- 1. The two parties shall encourage cooperation, which includes the following activities:
  - a. Exchange of lecturers and students for further study, training, and giving lectures;
  - b. Collaborative research and joint academic meetings;
  - c. Exchange of information, publications and materials for academic purposes;
  - d. Exchange of professors and researchers;
  - e. Friendly visits; and
  - f. Other activities as may be mutually agreed by the two parties to this Memorandum of Understanding.
- 2. The aforementioned activities shall be realized by means of consultation and the exchange of relevant information between appropriate members of the two parties.
- 3. The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is to develop and cooperation of education on the basis of equality, reciprocity and mutual benefit, and the promote relations and mutual understanding between the parties.
- 4. This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective immediately upon being singed by the official representatives of the two parties and shall remain valid of five (5) years, from June 2012 to June 2017. This Memorandum of Understanding may be renewed for a further period of five (5) years by mutual agreement prior to the date of expiry.
- 5. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual agreement.
