## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AND COOPERATION BETWEEN

### HOKKAIDO INFORMATION UNIVERSITY, JAPAN AND

# RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY THANYABURI, **THAILAND**

Hokkaido Information University, Japan and Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi, Thailand have agreed to establish a relationship between the two institutions as follows.

#### 1 Scope of the Agreement

- (1) Exchange of students;
- (2) Exchange of academic staff and administrators:
- (3) Promotion of joint research and education activities.

#### 2 General principles for Cooperation and Exchange

Specific arrangements for different types of exchanges will be made on a case by case basis. The following general principles will underpin cooperation and exchange activities:

- (1) The variety of cooperation and exchange will include student visits, faculty member and administrator visits, discussion about projects and communication through e-mail and letter.
- (2) Each institution will endeavor to ensure that in providing exchange opportunities, visiting staff and students have the maximum opportunity to learn and benefit from the cooperation and exchange.
- (3) All the necessary expenses required for academic exchange and cooperation will be based on agreement by both universities concerning each activity.

This Agreement will become effective from the date of signing by the representatives of both institutes and valid for the initial period of five years. This Agreement will be renewed after being reviewed and renegotiated by both institutes. The terms of this Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement in a written notice.

The agreement should be concluded in two original documents, both written in English language and being equally authentic.
