



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY THANYABURI

In recognition of the mutual benefits derived from scholastic partnership, College of Materials Science and Engineering, Tianjin University of Technology, P.R. China and Faculty of Engineering, Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi (RMUTT), Thailand, agree to promote academic cooperation.

PURPOSE

The general purpose of this agreement is to establish specific educational relations and linkage between the two participating school and faculty in order to promote academic cooperation and partnership.

AREAS OF COOPERATION

This MOA covers the following areas of cooperation under the two universities' respective academic procedures:

1. Exchange of staff, students and professor;
2. Joint research and development (R&D) and study visit;
3. Joint organization and conduct seminars, workshops, symposia and conferences;
4. Cooperation in providing degree and non-degree programs;

Themes of joint activities and conditions for utilizing the results achieved, as well as arrangements for visits, exchanges, and other executable forms of cooperation will be further discussed and developed mutually for each specific case. All financial arrangements will be discussed, depending on mutually agreed programs, projects and activities.

In order to carry out and fulfill the goals of this MOA, both parties will appoint coordinators for the design, development and management of joint activities. Through these coordinators, as contact persons, either party may initiate proposals for activities under this agreement. Specific details will be set forth in a separate Letter of Agreement (LOA) which will stand as the executable terms of this general arrangement, subject to the approval by appropriate authorities for both parties, under normal procedures. An LOA will include such items as:

1. Scope of responsibilities of each institution for any joint undertaking
2. Schedule of implementation of any joint undertaking
3. Budgetary plans and sources of financing for any joint undertaking
4. Any other items deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity.

The coordinators will further be responsible for the evaluation of activities under this agreement, in accordance to the practices of the respective party.

This document is a statement of understanding and is not intended to create binding or legal obligations on either party.

RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT

This MOA shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving notice to the other party in writing by mutual consent or by six months' notice by either party. Failing such notice, the agreement will be renewed for like periods by tacit consent of the parties.

This MOA may be amended by the exchange of letters between the two parties. Such amendments, once approved by both universities, will become part of this MOA.
